- To be eligible to win prizes, you must register for the adult reading club online via the green button above, or in person at the 2nd or 3rd floor desks.
- Each completed challenge gets you an entry into that week's prize draw, as well as into the grand prize draw at the end of the summer.
- Every five completed challenges count as an additional entry into the grand prize draw.
- Draws are every Friday from July 12 to Aug. 23 and the Grand Prize draw is on Aug. 30.
- One book or activity can be counted for multiple challenges. Each challenge may only be completed once per person.
- Challenges may be completed in any order.
- This challenge is open to anyone 17+. Older teens are welcome to complete the Adult Summer Reading Challenge and the [Teen Summer Reading Challenge](#) at the same time.
- All book formats can be counted towards the challenge, including ebooks, audiobooks, graphic novels, or however else you like to read!
